
Late S. P. Malhotra Founder Chairman (1927-2013)

The Programme provides full scholarships to over 125 students per year for Under Graduate (B.Sc.) and Post Graduate (M.Sc.) studies, for students of high merit, especially from the rural areas of Maharashtra, who lack the financial ability to carry on studies in these fields. In view of the socio-cultural context, where financially challenged families neglect higher education of girl students, the Malhotra WeiKFiELD Foundation Scholarship programme gives a strong preference to female students wishing to pursue higher studies in Pure Sciences.




Arrangement for internships at NCL, IISER, etc.



THE MALHOTRA WEIKFIELD FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS









"The Malhotra Weikfield Foundation Scholarships are awarded to students, primarily from the rural regions of Maharashtra; who are seriously interested in pursuing careers in Pure Sciences, viz, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Life Sciences and Nano Sciences, They should be enrolled either in B.Sc. or M.Sc. programmes.

The students are selected based on a combination of criteria, including academic performance, socio-economic background, gender, communication skills and socially relevant extra-curricular activities. The eligibility for selection is based on an on-line test and Formal interviews where the candidates are assessed on the above criteria.

The continuation of the Scholarship Award is subject to the students following all instructions, attending the workshops and their interactions with the Foundation and their respective Mentors".

Other than Graduate and Post-Graduate Science Scholarships, the Foundation also contributes to several other activities, such as:

- Scholarships for Management and Law students at Symbiosis.
- Scholarships for Nanotechnology at Bangalore.
- Scholarships to 500 school children from CES Chaitanya English Medium School and Junior College, Pune
- Central Food Technological Research Institute (CFTRI) Food Technology Scholarships
- Muktangan Exploratory Science Centre, Pune
- Set up of 2 Bakery Training Institutes under the Hotel Management & Catering Institute, Pune and Camp Education Society's Hotel Management College.
- In partnership with Janaseva Foundation, the Foundation has funded construction of about 1200 toilets in rural schools and villages under the "Swachh Bharat Abhiyaan" scheme through Rotary International
- The Foundation is also involved in essential humanitarian services by providing food and feeding about 2000 needy and hungry people every day, under the "Food for Life, Combat Hunger" scheme through Annamrita Foundation (part of ISKCON).
- Indo Swiss Center of Excellence, Pune (ISCEP): The Foundation has contributed the major seed investment in cash and land to set up ISCEP, a skill development institution to impart the "Skills of Tomorrow" in the field of Manufacturing and Agriculture at Koregaon Bhima, Pune.
